PREAMBLE

1. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- a) Admission to above said course shall be given once in a calendar year. Admission Notice is issued in the leading newspapers of the State and Country.
- b) Application for admission to the course is required to be submitted on the prescribed form. The application form is obtainable from the office of the College personally on cash payment of Rs.50/-
- c) The documents required are:
 - i) Mark sheet of Senior secondary/Secondary as per eligibility criteria of the course
 - ii) Admit/Certificate of secondary examination as age proof
 - iii) 4 copy photographs
 - iv) Appointment letter from the Employer (in case of employee)/Identity card.
 - v.) Aadhar card/Voter card

2. ELIGIBILITY FOR DIPLOMA COURSE –

Candidates who have passed 10 + 2 from any recognized Board/ CBSE/ ICSE preferably with Physics, Chemistry and Biology with 45 % percent marks is given priority for admission however the candidates who have passed 10 + 2 from any recognized Board/ CBSE/ ICSE board with atleast 50 % marks in aggregate can apply.

A candidate seeking admission to Diploma courses should have 17 years of age, as on 1st July 2025 and maximum age limit is 25 years. In case of SC and ST the upper age limit is 30 years.

3. Medium of instruction: - English shall be the medium of instruction for all the subjects of study and for the examination of all IMA courses.
4. **Practical training at Hospitals/diagnostics center during training: - -**
Six months to twelve months compulsory hand holding training is provided to different Government recognized hospitals and diagnostic centres as per West Bengal Clinical established Act 2017. Candidates for all courses are sent to clinical establishment for hand holding practical training.
5. **INTERNSHIP –** Six months internship is mandatory for all the courses. Candidates who has passed the final examination is sent for six months internship.

6. ATTENDANCE

A candidate is required to attend at least 75 percent in all subjects prescribed for the year, separately, in theory and practical/clinical postings to become eligible to appear for the examination.

7. Certification- All the certificates are issued by IMA (H.Q) and awarded to successful candidates.

Validity of Certificate- An IMA paramedical diploma is **valid and recognized** by some specific state governments (like the Govt. of NCT of Delhi) and widely within the private sector. However, its acceptance for **all government jobs across India is not uniform** and depends on the specific requirements of the recruiting government body

These diplomas are widely accepted and recognized in the private healthcare sector, including private hospitals, nursing homes, and diagnostic labs, and sometimes in semi-governmental settings. They are also recognized in some NABH (National Accreditation Board for Hospitals & Healthcare Providers) accredited hospitals

8. Session - For Diploma course the academic session is August and Jan every year

9. GUEST LECTURE

Students theoretical understanding is supplemented by a practical orientation developed through lecturers by leading academicians.

10. ASSIGNMENTS

Most of the subjects require assignments to be submitted by the specific dates.

11. INTERNAL EXAMINATION

In order to check the performance of the students SSMT conducts regular class tests etc.

12. STUDENTS PROGRESS REPORT

We keep close eye on the overall performance of the student and send monthly progress report of students to their parents/guardians.

13. STUDENT FEEDBACK

Management of the college takes regular feedback from students regarding faculty and other related problems etc. and tries to sort their problems on top priority.

14. STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

We apply all sincere & possible efforts to shape the career of the students so as to make them not only a complete Professional but also a responsible citizen. Students are provided with all sorts of modern amenities and extra ordinary care is taken towards over all development of their personality.

15. INFRASTRUCTURE

SSMT has well-furnished Air-conditioned class rooms, library, Practical room, staff

room & other infrastructural facility. Due to security reason college has recently installed close circuit cameras inside the college building in every room. Infrastructure is built as per the norms of appropriate Government authority.

Teaching Aids

To supplement the course, texts relevant video & audio tapes are screened from time to time. To strengthen the teaching learning process the college has provided the much-needed aids like LCD projector and other modern teaching equipment.

16. BOOK BANK FACILITY

College has library cum reading room for students comprising of text books, reference books etc.

17. PRACTICAL NOTEBOOK & APRON

Every student has to purchase apron or practical note book at his/her own cost from outside.

18. SEMINARS



College also organizes seminars on various National Events such as World Aids Day, World Environment Day and other important days.

19. RULES AND REGULATIONS

Violation of rules will result in disciplinary action against the offender including his/her suspension and/or discharge from the college. A student may be expelled from the college at any times on the following grounds

1. Unsatisfactory conduct
 2. When his/her activities are found detrimental to the interest of the college, management or other students.
 3. When he/she indulge in unlawful/ anti-national activities.
 4. When payment of fee is delayed beyond the prescribed time schedule.
 5. When he/she is absent for more than 3 days without any application/information.
20. **Placement** – Students gets employment after this intensive 2000 hours of hand holding practical in the same hospital where he/she done this practical training. Usually 60-70 % students got this opportunity in past few years as we observed. More over students get practical training certificate from those big hospitals and clinical establishment like Woodland Multispecialty hospital, Ruby Multispecialty hospital, Apollo Multispecialty hospital, JBCH Multispecialty hospital and many more and diagnostic centre like Lupin Diagnostic, Suraksha Diagnostic, Agilus Diagnostic etc helps them to get job in other big hospitals and diagnostic centre. We keep the keep the students updated placement information through our own placement portal.
